FORM 4 – MINOR CHILDREN OF BAHAMIAN CITIZENS

The Following documents are also needed in support of your application:

- Application forms are to be completed in duplicate
- Birth Certificate.
- All payments MUST be in the form of International U.S. Postal Money Order
- Parents' Birth Certificate
- Police Certificate if older than 14 years
- 2 passports – size photographs
- A \$10.00 Bahamian postage stamp
- Letters from all schools attended indicating dates of entry and completion. Application must be notarized by a Justice of the Peace or Notary Public
- Parents' passport, naturalization certificate (if applicable)
- A processing fee of \$100.00 cash/money order payable to the Public Treasury.
